



Setting up your Brush Cutter is most important! Never walk behind when mower is operating. Keep front deck slightly higher then the rear. Mower will sink in grass about 2", so adjust accordingly. When you are unfamiliar with the area your cutting, play it safe and mow 8" higher then normal. Then you can see to remove dangerous objects for your next mowing.



Gear Boxes should never be over filled! Use 80-90W Gear oil. Use grease on bot ends of the PTO shaft zerks.









Do not raise wheel off ground more then 2'. We suggest 1'. Set tractor 3pt settings to keep within safe range.......
